Have you heard of the National PTA Reflections Program?

Have you ever thought about entering?

This is a great opportunity for all students to participate, **including students with disabilities**.

What is Reflections?

National PTA Reflections is an **arts program** which invites students from all grades and abilities to explore and be involved in the arts. PTA schools in good standing are eligible to participate in Reflections. Students create original works of art based on a common theme for the year. Students can receive awards and can advance from the local (school) PTA level to Council, Region, State and even National PTA to be recognized.

2026-2027 Reflections Theme: **What My Culture Means to Me**

When should I start working on my entry and when is it due?

You can start working on your entry **now**. Deadlines are set by individual schools. Most schools choose a due date in the first two weeks of October. To find out the deadline for your school, contact your local PTA President. Call the school to get their contact information.

What are the Divisions? *Primary (preschool-grade 2) *Intermediate (grades 3-5) *Middle school (grades 6-8)
*High school (grades 9-12) *Accessible Arts (includes up to age 22)

What is the Accessible Arts Division?

The Accessible Arts Division is an **option** for students who have a disability. This division allows students to have the opportunity and accommodations they may need to participate fully in the program. The Accessible Arts Division offers modified rules and guidelines and also allows for some accommodations. Proof of disability is not required.

Which Division should I enter?

Students with disabilities may choose to enter **their** grade level Division or they can enter the Accessible Arts Division.
